Location: University of North Alabama ROTC Building (Wesleyan Hall Annex)

- Alan Riethmaier announced that as of March 1 all but two district units that were expected to re-charter in 2008 had done so.
- The deadline to register for the 2008 Cub Scout Day Camp and avoid the late fee is May 16. The cost is \$60 per scout and the late fee is \$25. Camp dates are June 9-13 at Camp Westmoreland. This year camp will have an evening schedule (4-9 pm). Please contact Cathy Davis (386-0361/catrandavis@comcast.net) if you know of someone willing to assist. This includes older boy scouts. Note that no program will be provided for incoming (new) Tiger Cubs. Ms. Davis will gladly visit cub units to promote the day camp. Leaders needing to schedule an information meeting should contact her.
- Alan mentioned that both Camp Sequoyah and Camp Comer summer camps have already filled up for some weeks. Units are encouraged to submit registrations soon to assure getting a time slot.
- The first district committee meeting of the year will be held March 27. Representatives from each unit are encouraged to attend. The time and location of this meeting will be posted electronically and persons on the e-mail distribution list will be contacted by e-mail.
- The District Pinewood Derby will be held Saturday, March 29, 2008 at Regency Square Mall in Florence. Registration begins at 8:00 am and ends at 10:00 am when racing begins. A \$5.00 entry fee is required, which includes a patch. Rules and details may be found at www.westmorelanddistrict.com.
- Camp Comer is hosting Cub Adventure weekends April 18-20 and 25-27. Registration forms are available from the council web site.
- The Spring Camporee to be held April 25-27 at Camp Westmoreland will celebrate the 80th anniversary of the camp. Troops should register now. Many special activities are planned. This camporee could be used as a recruiting vehicle for incoming (prospective) Webelos scouts to move up to boy scout units.
- Outdoor Leader Skills (adult) training will be held at Camp Westmoreland May 9-10. The cost is \$25.
- Alan mentioned that the 2008 unit marketing award applications can be downloaded from the Internet. These awards include Camperships for winning units.
- Alan requested that people send him feedback on the Roundtable meeting location. The first meeting at UNA (in February) was well attended. However, attendance was very low for this most recent meeting.
- The April Roundtable meeting (April 3) will feature some adult leader training as part of the program.
